Tom Lehman, who led the season-long race most of the year, held on to capture the 2011 Charles Schwab Cup by a slim margin. He was voted Player of the Year by his peers, making him the first player in history to earn the Player of the Year award on all three Tours operated by the PGA TOUR. Lehman was also the only player to surpass \$2 million in earnings in 2011.
